Mr Liu's application was accepted for processing by the Business Migration Branch on 13 August 2002.

Mr Liu wishes to set up a joint venture including Well Lee Ltd, Equus Hawk 08 Ltd and Tian Long Property Development Co Ltd who will export large quantities of agricultural and horticultural products to China.

It is hoped that products from the company will be available to the market in July 2003.
